

RBW Manager

The RBW Manager form will contain three buttons: New, Refresh and Delete, as well as a list of existing RBW definitions.

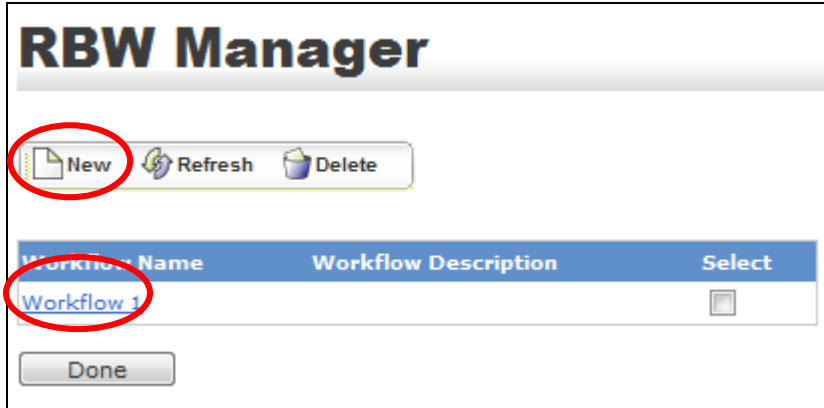


Figure 7 – RBW Manager

RBW definition Editor

From the RBW Manager form, press <NEW> to create a new RBW definition, or select the hyperlink to edit an existing RBW definition.

The RBW definition Editor appears.

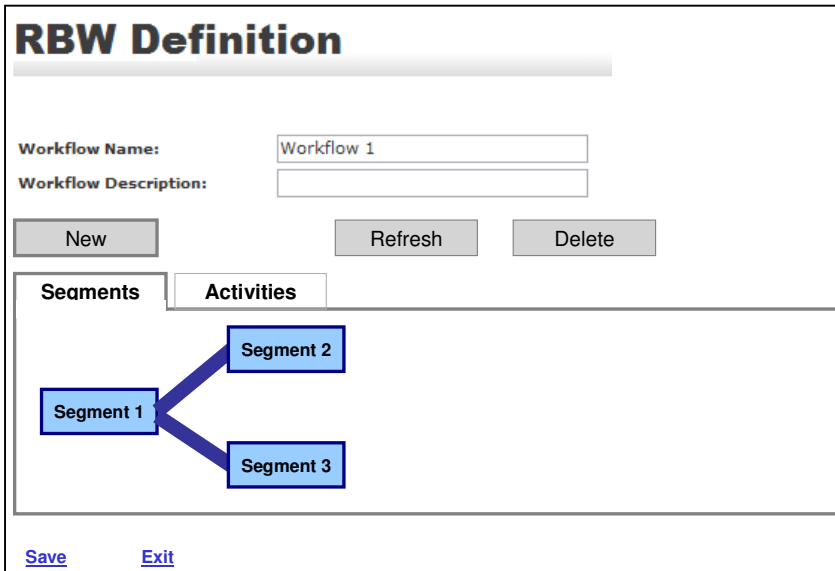


Figure 8 – RBW definition Editor

The RBW definition Manager contains two tabs: one for defining segments, and the other for defining activities for the selected segment.

New Segments

To create a new segment, press <NEW>. If no segments exist, then a segment will be created. Otherwise, if a segment is selected then a new segment will be created after the selected segment;

Segments will be sequential by default. However, if two or more segments are created after a selected segment, then the new segments will be parallel.

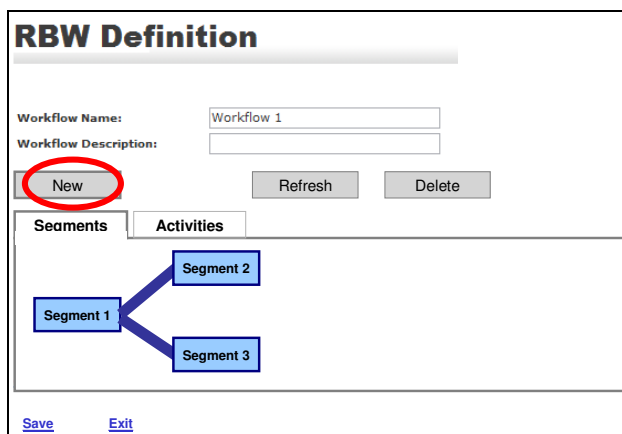


Figure 9 – Creating a new segment

Deleting Segments

To delete a segment, select the segment and press <DELETE>. A prompt will appear to confirm the delete. If a sequential segment is disconnected as a result of the delete, it will be reconnected to the adjacent segment.

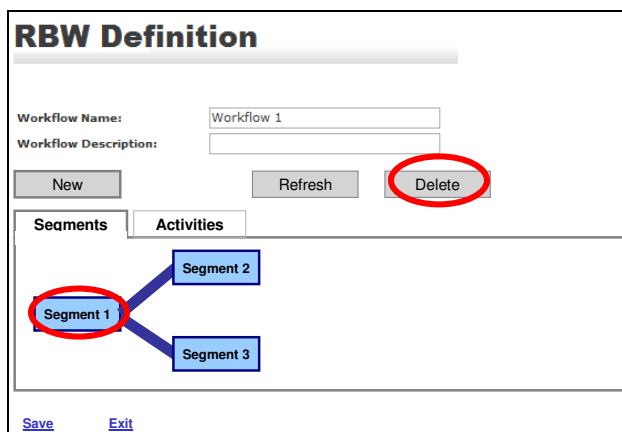


Figure 10 – Deleting a segment

Editing Segments

To edit a segment, double-click. The “Activities” tab will open. The Activities tab contains three columns of information:

- 1) **The Activities list** shows a sequence of workflow activities;
 - a. **New Activity:** Select an activity, and press the <NEW> button to add an activity after the activity;
 - b. **Delete an Activity:** Select an activity, and press the <DELETE> button to remove the activity;
 - c. **Sequence an Activity:** Select an activity, and press the up/down arrows to change the sequence of the activity;
- 2) **The Permissions list** contains available permissions, which are associated with the selected activity. Select or deselect the desired permissions for the selected activity. Scroll bars will allow for lengthy permission lists.
- 3) **The Users list** contains available users, which are associated with the selected activity. Select or deselect the desired permissions for the selected activity. Scroll bars will allow for lengthy user lists.
